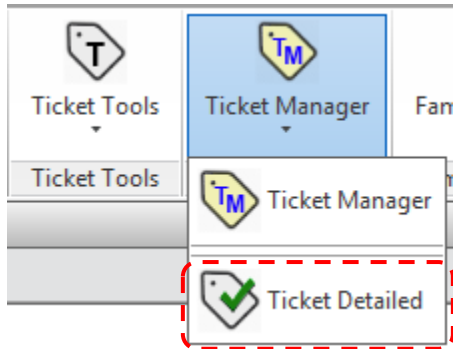


Ticket Manager: Ticket Detailed



Programmed Result of Tool:

This tool will mark a Ticket/Assembly as Detailed and ready for Checking. Included in the actions of this tool is the automatic update of parameters which are used in the Ticket Manager main display and Edit History dialog as well as automatically updating the Drawn By initials and Date labels for each ticket sheet associated with the Ticket/Assembly.

Steps to Perform tool Operation:

Within an open Ticket Sheet view, the user clicks the tool icon to mark the ticket as Detailed (completed).

- 1) If not currently open, the user opens a ticket sheet specific to the Ticket.
- 2) User clicks the Ticket Detailed icon.
- 3) EDGE[^]R pushes the username and date to the Ticket Manager adds a comment to the Edit History of the ticket, then prompts the user his/her initials. The user's initials and the current date are then pushed to the title blocks of each sheet associated with the current ticket.
- 4) The user then provides the initials for population onto each sheet associated with the ticket.

Populates the title blocks of the active ticket with the initials entered in this dialog.
