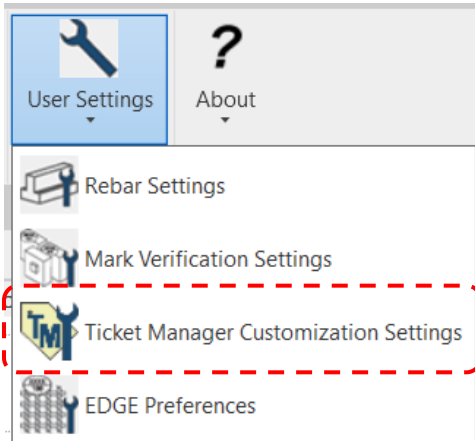


User Settings: Ticket Manager Customization Settings



Programmed Result of Tool:

This tool allows the user to choose up to four custom parameters to add to the Ticket Manager window. From the Ticket Manager, users will be able to edit these parameter values on assemblies and/or structural framing elements.

Once saved, a settings file named “<<Project Manufacturer Name>>_TicketManagerCustomizationSettings.txt” will be saved to a user defined folder. This folder is determined by the folder path selected for the Ticket Manager Custom Folder Path within the EDGE Preferences settings.

Steps to Perform tool Operation:

- 1) To start, select from one of the drop downs to choose a parameter. Only Project Parameters applied to the Assemblies and/or Structural Framing categories will be available in the drop-down to choose from. Also, only Text and Yes/No type parameters will be available to choose from. (Note: any drop downs left blank will not be added to the Ticket Manager.)
- 2) In the text field above the drop down, enter in the name that you wish to appear as the column header in the Ticket Manager. If this field is left blank, then the parameter name will be displayed in the Ticket Manager as the column header value.
- 3) Click save to save the custom parameters to your Ticket Manager Customization Settings File.

Clicking any of the clear buttons will clear that custom parameter. Clicking Reset File will clear out any information from the current Settings file and close the customization tool.
